

Player Movement from Juniors to Seniors

Agreement with SBFC and SBJFC 7/2/2019

Our steps are as follows

1. Senior club decides they need players
2. Approaches the junior coach of the child
 - a. Yes – goes to step 3
 - b. No – goes to the Junior President/Junior Liaison for further discussion on reasons why, ensuring they are sufficient.
3. Approaches the parent
 - a. Yes - Gets a Type 2 Permit signed by the parent for the rest of the season and go to Step 4
 - b. No – No play
4. Approaches the child
 - a. Yes – Plays
 - b. No – No play

Senior Coaches must not go directly to the player or parent and have a systematic approach, wherever possible.

Junior Coaches agree with the concept of developing players and rewarding those that “deserve” playing up, ability and work/attendance determines that opportunity.

All parties agree that there will be exceptions which need to be discussed.

All parties must communicate in the correct manner, follow the process and agree that communication is the key.
